

MORGAN COUNTY SHERIFF'S RODEO QUEEN CONTRACT (18-26)

YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO COMPETE IN THE MRUSA PAGEANT _____

1. The Queen Pageant Committee reserves the right to determine if the Queen will represent MCSR in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at the Miss Rodeo USA pageant. _____
2. The Queen must have the financial resources to attend the MRUSA pageant (includes the purchase or access to a wardrobe suitable for a national level pageant, travel expenses and clinics or coaching.) _____
3. If the Queen will be attending the MRUSA pageant in January of the following year of her reign, all preparations such as wardrobe, scrapbook, speeches and any other requirements pertaining to the MRUSA pageant shall be completed by January 1. The remaining time will be for incidentals. _____
4. If the Queen is required to ride a horse (whether it is her personal horse or a horse that has been made available for her) in any event, the animal will be of good weight, healthy, clean and groomed. The horse shall maintain a current Coggins and proper hoof care during the queen's 1 year reign. _____
5. The Queen is required to keep the MCSR saddle and a flag boot in her possession at all events in which she participates. Should the Queen have to ride in a saddle other than the MCSR saddle, it will be her responsibility to make sure it is clean and presentable.

6. The Queen is always to arrive at all events at least ½ hour early and be willing to help.

7. The Queen will not appear at ANY event without prior approval from the Pageant Director or Queen Pageant Committee. _____
8. The Queen will be required to make appearances during her reign at her expense. A horse will be required at several of the events and is the responsibility of the Queen.*

9. The Queen shall never appear at required functions/events without being dressed in proper rodeo attire. Long sleeve or leather western/show shirt, clean pressed jeans or trousers, polished boots, clean hat, well-groomed fingernails, styled hair (curled, queen type hair style), etc... No visible body piercings such as: eyebrow studs, nose rings, lip

piercings, tongue studs, excessive earrings/studs. Remember, all eyes are on you. The Sheriff or Queen Pageant Committee reserves the right to decide if a piercing(s) is inappropriate. _____

10. The Queen's crown, banner and buckle shall be worn from the time she steps out of her vehicle at an event/function until the time she exits the event/function. _____
11. No foul language, consumption of alcohol, smoking, flirting, public displays of affection that can be misinterpreted, or any behavior deemed inappropriate by the Sheriff or Queen Pageant Committee will be tolerated. Behavior shall be constantly observed. The Queen shall **ALWAYS** remember that she is representing the Morgan County Sheriff as well as Morgan County. _____
12. **Social media shall always be appropriate. All language, photographs, etc... shall be of excellent moral standards...absolutely no photographs with any visible body piercings or tattoos, other than earrings.** The Sheriff or Queen Pageant Committee reserves the right to decide if a social status or post is inappropriate. _____
13. The Queen shall have tear sheets made as soon as possible (within 30 days). Tear sheets should be in your possession at all times during an appearance. _____
14. NO ONE wears the MCSR crown except the current Queen. It is not a toy and is the sole responsibility of the Queen to safeguard. If the MCSR crown is lost or damaged, it will be the responsibility of the Queen to have it replaced or repaired at the discretion of Tres Rios Silver of Llano, TX at the current replacement value or repair value. _____
15. The Queen shall be responsible for sending thank you notes/letters to all sponsors.
16. If the Queen is not fulfilling her duties as MCSR Queen, the Queen Pageant Committee and/or the Sheriff, reserves the right to dismiss her as Queen. If that should occur, it is the responsibility of the Queen to return the crown, banner, buckle and all awarded prizes. _____
17. The Queen shall be responsible for contacting current title holders to carry flags in parades. The Queen shall carry the American flag. The Senior Miss shall carry the State Flag. The Junior Miss shall carry the MCSR Queen Pageant Flag. The Little Miss shall carry the MCS Posse Flag. In the event that title holders are unable to fulfill their duty, the Queen, at her discretion, will appoint whomever she chooses as flag girls. _____
